Sabine Salloch is full professor and head of the Institute for Ethics, History and Philosophy of Medicine at Hannover Medical School (MHH). Her areas of expertise are professionalism and interprofessionalism in healthcare, ethics of digitization and bioethical methodology.



Planetary Health Ethics: from bedside to bench and back

The increasing recognition of interdependencies between human health, global societies and natural environments as mirrored in the concept of Planetary Health affects both, health care and medical research in their various dimensions. The talk will examine ethical questions arising in the intersection of health and environmental protection by starting from the clinical domain and key issues related to patient autonomy, professional activism and the attempt to overcome anthropocentric perspectives. As all clinical action needs a profound evidential basis a link will then be drawn to clinical and health-related research and its ethical affordances from a Planetary Health viewpoint. Finally, the talk will suggest further perspectives with respect to clinical practice, research strategies and bioethical theory building.
