## **Postdoctoral Research Fellow (m/f/d) in Political Theory and Global Governance of Technoscience (Salary Scale 13 TV-L "FwN", 50-100 %)**

starting February 1, 2023 (or shortly thereafter). The position is limited to December 31, 2024. The scope of employment may be up to 100% if desired, but above 50% requires regular teaching responsibilities. This position necessitates regular presence in Hannover, with the possibility of part-time remote working arrangement.

### **Responsibilities and tasks**

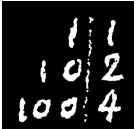
- Humanities and social science research on the intersection of global grassroots movements and science and technology governance
- Collaboration with CELLS faculty on research coordination, preparing funding applications, and publications
- Teaching activities (depending on contract working time)

### **Required competencies**

- Completed university science degree in social sciences or humanities
- A relevant doctoral degree is desired; a regional focus (e.g. Latin America or Southeast Asia and Pacific Islands) and an interdisciplinary approach in the dissertation is highly desirable
- Demonstrated competence in political theory (including postcolonial and Indigenous critiques) and qualitative research methods
- Knowledge of and/or work experience within international non-governmental organizations or advocacy groups in the global South
- English-language communication skills, written and spoken
